

AWARENESS AND SENSITIZATION WORKSHOP



We are delighted to share the news of a highly successful awareness and sensitisation workshop that took place on August 30, 2023. This workshop was a significant step forward in addressing childhood deafness and the associated challenges that our society faces.

The workshop was specifically designed for 101 dedicated Anganwadi workers from the Goroimari neighbourhood, located in the Chaygaon block of Kamrup district. These Anganwadi workers play a vital role in the community, working closely with families and children to provide essential early childhood care and education services.
