OUR VIRTUAL EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS

In the current pandemic situation, our teachers have been conducting regular virtual sessions with children whose parents have smartphones. Children whose parents do not have smartphones were given information through audio calls and sms. Our teachers provide lesson plans and activity details over call and train parents so that the same can be practiced in a home environment. We have conducted **18000** virtual sessions and reached **600** deaf children and **1200** families



WE CONDUCTED HOME VISITS

We have been conducting home visits to provide individualised educational sessions to children living in remote locations keeping in mind all the safety needs of the children, their family and teachers. During the visit, children are taught various concepts based on their lesson plans and are provided with Nutritional Supplements and Educational activity books so that the parent can reinforce the learnings from the session at home. We have conducted **1400** physical sessions.



NEWBORN HEARING SCREENING PROGRAMME

Our "NewBorn Hearing Screening" programme has been running at Tumkur district hospital Karnataka from Monday to Friday using 'Sohum' Screening Device. Now we have expanded this programme to Sira taluk hospital, Tumkur Karnataka. Till now **2500** babies have been screened.



DIGITAL CAMPAIGN ON PROTECTING CHILDREN WITH HEARING IMPAIREMENT AGAINST CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE


VAANI conducted a digital campaign to sensitise and mobilize general public against sexual abuse of Children with hearing impairment from 23rd September to 23rd December 2020. We have been able to reach 4000 individuals through social media drive.

As part of this campaign we conducted a 10 day online training session for our parents, NGO Partners and teachers from West Bengal, Assam and Karnataka.






VIRTUAL VOLUNTEERING ENGAGEMENTS


