COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM

School Awareness Program at Anukul Chandra High School. There were 64 enthusiastic students and 7 dedicated teachers part of this. The program focused on awareness about the causes of hearing impairment, prevention, and how to foster a deaf-friendly school environment. The session also covered essential do's and don'ts for maintaining ear health & hygiene.



The training programs in Kishanganj and Siliguri, West Bengal, were a resounding success! We equipped 100 dedicated Anganwadi and Asha workers with essential skills in ear health, early identification of hearing impairment, parent counseling techniques, and communication through Indian Sign Language.

Building on this achievement, we are excited to launch a similar initiative in partnership with Pandua Pratabandhi Kalyan Samity, continuing our mission to empower communities with the knowledge and tools to support children with hearing impairments.



LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION

Empowering Students for Holistic Development



At VAANI, our Life Skills Education program is designed to empower families and students beyond academics by equipping them with essential skills for holistic development. The program helps students understand and express their emotions, communicate effectively—including using Indian Sign Language—make informed decisions, and solve problems with confidence.

We also focus on health and hygiene awareness, teaching the importance of nutrition and personal care. Additionally, students learn to manage stress through mindfulness techniques and are encouraged to become responsible, empathetic members of their community. This comprehensive approach prepares them for the challenges of everyday life.

BASIC AND ADVANCED COMPUTER

Computer Sessions in Guwahati, Kolkata, Siliguri, and Malancha centres! are designed to empower our Children With Hearing Impairment (CWHI) by focusing on practical computer applications that spark creativity and enhance problem-solving skills.

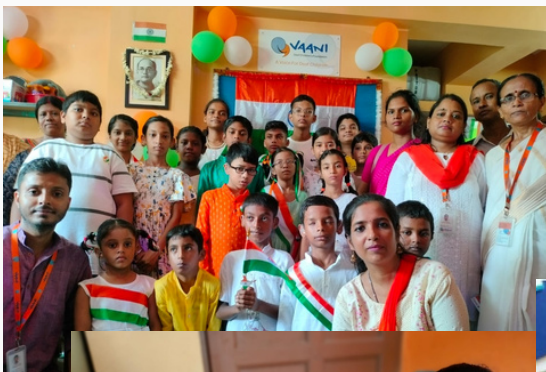
FOUNDATION DAY
