# Awareness and Sensitization Workshop & Camps Across.





We are delighted to share our recent awareness sensitization workshops and community camps held at various zones. These workshops mark a significant step forward in addressing childhood deafness and the many challenges it presents within our communities.

Each session is thoughtfully designed for Anganwadi workers and frontline early-childhood educators & professionals, who play a pivotal role in supporting families and young children. By equipping these dedicated workers with knowledge and tools, we aim to strengthen early childhood care and education services at the grassroots level.

#### Sessions focused on

- Understanding childhood deafness and recognising early signs
- Importance of early identification and timely intervention
- Basic sign-language sessions to encourage everyday communication
- On-site screening and guidance camps to connect families with referral services

Through interactive discussions, presentations, hands-on activities, and health camps, participants gain the skills and confidence to identify concerns early and guide families toward appropriate support.
